Mommy and Jonathan are recovering so very well, and both of them look great! God has richly blessed us with another "arrow in our quiver," and we are excited to see what plans God has in store for David and Jonathan. Our first "long" trip is in just a few weeks, so pray Jonathan adapts quickly to the life of deputation.



Speaking of deputation, God continues to use us and our ministry on deputation. God has richly blessed with people saved and some young men surrendering their lives to full-time Christian service. Recently I had the opportunity to visit my brother in Kentucky between meetings. During my stay there, I went soul winning with a man in the church my brother attends. The very first couple we spoke to was a younger couple with a young daughter who used to ride the Sunday school bus. Within a few minutes, both the mother and father of this young girl were being dealt with about salvation. Both parents bowed their heads and received Christ as their Saviour. That young impressionable girl went from a home where little hope was to a home full of hope, faith, and a bright future in Christ! What a joy it was to see the "new life" in Christ

glisten in their eyes and see that Christ had just saved a home!

Holly and I are thankful that we are nearing the end of the deputation trail. We have had several churches pick us up for support, bringing us to about 88%.
