Holly, our boys, and I had the opportunity to spend this Christmas season with our families, and we enjoyed doing so one last time here in the States.

Since celebrating the birth of Christ, I have had the opportunity to present a gift to Jesus—an older lady who lives just a couple of blocks away from our home base who had never received the Greatest Gift of All, Jesus Christ. I showed her how she could personally receive the FREE gift of salvation. She gladly received Him and became a child of the King!

Holly and I have been extremely busy packing, preparing paperwork, and finalizing things for our departure date on February 19th. It is less than two months away now, and we are very excited to be going home. In preparation for our move, there are several things we would like for you to pray with us about:

1. **Our Visas:** The UK government has just completely changed the application and things needed to apply. This has delayed some things and has added some complications. Please pray that God gives us wisdom to handle government dealings appropriately.
2. **Moving Expenses:** God has blessed with much of our needed funds to move, but we are in need of an additional \$9,500. Higher taxes, fuel surcharges on our container, and new visa requirements have necessitated this increase. Please pray with us concerning this need, and if there is any way you could help, it would be greatly appreciated.
3. **A Smooth Transition:** There will be many adjustments as we get acclimated to a new culture and a different society. Pray that God will give us wisdom, patience, understanding, and grace as we make this transition.
