Dear Brethren and Friends,

As the warm days here in Central Mexico have stopped, the rainy season has begun. We are so thankful for the results we have seen in both of our ministries in Guanajuato. By the time we park the two vehicles we use to pick up riders for church, they look so dirty because the roads are very muddy, and as I clean the vehicles, the only encouragement I find is to know that some people rode these muddy vehicles got saved or went to hear God's Word preached. We now average 70 in our ministry in Apaseo El Grande, and we are out of space in the children's church.

Knowing of the need of a bigger place, I went looking for another place to rent. Seeking advice from a veteran pastor, we will begin to build on a piece of land that was given to the ministry. The land is rather small, but there are some properties close to the one that was given that are for sale. We are praying and seeking God's will to decide what needs to be done.

In our ministry in San Miguel de Allende, we have four faithful families. One of them had a miracle happen to them. Carla got saved in our ministries, and she was expecting a baby. When the baby was born, the doctors told her the baby would die from a lung complication. They told me and the church, and we prayed for the baby. At the last service we had, they came and told how the baby has miraculously come off the breathing equipment and is now breathing on her own. The same night the baby's grandmother gave a testimony of how she prayed that if the Lord took the baby home, they would still love God. She said that this prayer was made being encouraged by the message I gave the week before about Job's life. The families are growing in their faith and are getting more serious about God's business.

We are working on making it possible for some of our teenagers to go to Youth Camp in the month of July.

As the heat has decreased because of the rain, the scorpions have not showed up at our house anymore. My wife is very happy and hopes these little creatures will leave for good. Recently she had an accident because she slipped going down the stairs with one of our babies in her arms. Since we have not seen rain since we got in the house, we had not discovered that there was a leak in our roof above the steps that caused my wife to slip. Thank God for rain!! The other children are doing fine. Kyla will be done with first grade, and next September Joseph will join homeschool. Kyla is getting better with the Spanish.

We will like to share these needs in both of our ministries: (1) safety as we keep ministering, (2) more open doors to see people saved, (3) equipment for the church—chairs, windows, and doors for the church and Junior Church, (4) another passenger van, (5) more land on which to build (we need about \$10,000.00 to buy more land and begin to build).
