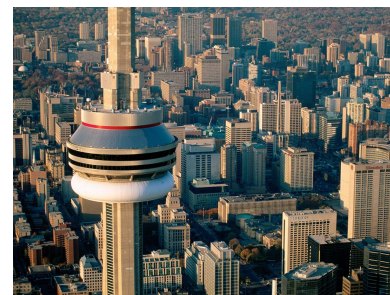

Dear Pastors, Supporting Churches, and Praying Friends and Family,

Thank you for being faithful to the cause of our Saviour. He came to seek and to save the lost. Through your prayers and financial support, you are helping lost people in Toronto to know the Lord Jesus Christ! Just about three weeks ago, my heart was so blessed to see a Chinese man named David Liu trust Christ as Saviour. We had prayed for him and witnessed to him for over three years. David and his wife, Ellen Zhao, were baptized the following Sunday.

On November 7th, I was dropping off a family after church—a Filipino lady named Beth and her two teenage daughters named Miah and Xiara. The mom was already saved, but I was unsure about the girls' salvation. So we got out of the van and stood in the driveway for almost an hour. I had the privilege of sharing the Gospel with them, and they both trusted Christ as their Saviour. It was sure a time of rejoicing for their mother!

Last week I was able to take those two girls and three others to their first youth conference. Pray that these teenagers would develop a heart for God and a passion to serve Him with their lives. Pray that these teenagers and another teen boy named Brandon (who was saved recently) would be faithful to church and understand that God sees something bigger and better for their lives than anything the world has to offer.

On November 14th, we had our fifth annual "*Veterans' & Military Appreciation Sunday*." We had twelve veterans and military personnel that attended, several visitors, and a senior married couple that prayed to receive Christ as their Saviour. That's what it's really all about—thank the Lord for someone getting saved!

Pray for pastors and churches to respond to the DVD we made concerning our ministry and decide to support our ministry. We will step out in faith in the coming years to start new ministries and to send people from our church to plant new churches, but the Lord's work does require money. Pray that God would supply the need for finances and for labourers! May God bless you for your faithfulness and sacrifice for the Lord's work! As I just wrote that word *sacrifice*, I was convicted in my heart. Nothing we can ever give—whether it be money or a lifetime of service—is really a sacrifice.
