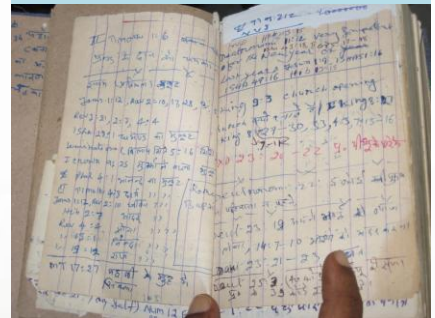
Dear Pastor and Friends,

I learned a great deal while there and did well in spite of the humid 105°F conditions. I heard several moving testimonies of believers who have suffered much for the sake of the Lord Jesus.
