About ten minutes later he ran in excited to share that he had just won his first two people to Christ—in Spanish! Glory! We rejoiced with him, and he ran back out to play. Shortly after, we went out to check on them, and he was witnessing to a third, who also got saved! What a joy to see our children as a part of the ministry. What a precious treasure our children are!
