Dear Pastors and Supporting Friends,

In mid-January I added another assignment to our ministry. With the permission of their administrator, I teach English to students at the local high school after hours on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Along with learning English usage and grammar, and with the help of Theresa and Kara, the young people are reading aloud from the KJV and are learning church songs. We were able to put a hard-bound New Testament with Psalms in each person's hand. There has been an attendance of over 100 on some afternoons.

Our seminary work is going well. I recently completed teaching a course on Psalms and Proverbs, and I will start a class now on the Doctrine of Man. I am instructing another group in our Saturday morning college on the Doctrine of God.

It is Mardi Gras time. The Haitian government sponsors this event across the country every year. School is dismissed this week, and some businesses are closed. We have invited the youth of two other churches to stay at our school facilities until Karnaval is over. The young people are enjoying the fellowship, meals, preaching, and activities.

Our evangelism has not diminished. We set aside time at least twice a week at the local market or in our neighborhood. In their most recent Bible Club, Theresa and Kara had 70 attend. That is a good number in one yard.

Thank you very much for your prayers and financial gifts. You encourage us as we serve in Haiti.
