


SERVING WITH TEAM GHANA

For almost six years, we have had the opportunity of working with Team Ghana, during which time I have been able to preach the Gospel to over 100,000 people. Many of these have prayed to receive Christ as their personal Saviour. We are grateful for these years that God has allowed us to serve Him here and for your investment, which made this all possible. We believe now that it is time to return to the States. This was not an easy decision to make, but we assure you it has been done with much prayer.

It is my desire that you would prayerfully consider transferring our support to Team Ghana or to one of the missionary families on the team. There is much being done here for the cause of Christ: souls being saved, people being discipled, and churches being started. But there is still much to be done. This is a hardworking group of missionaries dedicated to getting the Gospel out and around the world. I am confident that you will not be disappointed with any investment you choose to make in Team Ghana.

May 26 will be our last day here in Ghana. We will spend the month of June in Kansas with family. On July 7, we will be relocating back to Northwest Indiana to rejoin the First Baptist Church in Hammond, Indiana.
