The way in which we scheduled this meeting was a miracle in itself. We visited a church on a Sunday evening completely by faith, and there was a guest speaker. After the service he invited us to come to the church that he pastors in order to share the ministry in Tanzania to which God is directing us. We were delighted and amazed at God's very clear leading in providing this meeting for us. Actually, this has become the "usual" way we have gotten meetings.

We thank God for miraculously supplying our needs and for continually leading us to new churches. Praise the Lord! We have meetings scheduled for every Sunday through the second week of April. Please pray that we will continue to be sensitive to God's leading as He directs us to new churches that will have a desire to partner with us in His work. He is faithful, and our generation needs to see that faithfulness through our lives of faith in Him.
