Dear Praying Friends,

I am very glad to report that **Andy Richey**, one of our Team East Africa members, and I will be **leaving for Kenya**, along with his **son Stephen**, on **June 26**. We will be met in Kenya by **Pastor Darrell Hurst**, who is returning from Zambia, and a national pastor from Tanzania.

Our **Pastors' Conference** is organized, and we are expecting a good crowd of national pastors and church leaders. We will be having four 1½-hour teaching and preaching sessions throughout the day. Along with soul winning, we will also be reaching out to the local population while **trialing new video equipment** in the evening, showing a **Christian video, along with a Gospel message**. We are expecting hundreds of people to attend the evening sessions.

After the conference, **my wife Melody and our daughter Lindsay, along with Bro. Richey's wife Connie**, will be joining us to do a **survey trip** in preparation for the first members of Team East Africa to move to Kenya.

The work in Kenya continues as the pastors work in their various ministries. **Pastor Richard Omariba** has handed over his church in Monyero to **Pastor Kennedy**, while he has started a **new work in Nairobi**. **Pastor Cyrus Wanyonyi Chefunea** recently had an evangelistic meeting where **383 souls were saved and 34 new converts were baptized**. **Pastor Jeremiah Bosire Nyagaka** has trained a number of younger men to lead his church, and he believes God is **leading him to start a new church in Mombasa**. **Pastor Kennedy Obiko Ototo** has recently returned from **Meru, Wajir, and Garissa**, where recently a number of people were killed by the **Al-Shabaab**. He saw **35 saved**.

So the work continues. Team East Africa and I look forward to the time when we have a team on the ground and can do even more to see converts disciplined and God working through us and through these dedicated pastors. A common theme from the national pastors is **"We need a college."** This trip we will also be introducing a new curriculum to them aimed at discipling new Christians and equipping them for followship, internship, and leadership. This will teach the students how to **use their Bibles in their own environment to grow and to teach others also**. **BEAMS ministry** has also given us **300 Swahili and 100 English Bibles** to give these pastors, for which we are very grateful.
