The Lord continues to use our ministry here in Lima for His purpose and glory. We are constantly looking to make discipleship more practical and accessible for every church member. In light of that, we moved our primary soul-winning time from Saturday mornings—a very sleepy time in our part of the city—to Wednesday evenings prior to our midweek Bible study. The switch has resulted in many more church folks turning out for soul winning and many more people being saved. We've had a number of people won to Christ an hour before the service and then attending the service an hour later!

It has been said that one of the best places to rear a child is on the mission field. During our new soul-winning time, our oldest son Timothy has begun to be a real testimony to that statement. Most public schools here have school on a rotation. There are morning classes for half the children and afternoon classes for the other half. School dismisses during our soul-winning time, and it has presented several great opportunities for Timo to witness to boys his age. Just recently he led 8 boys to Christ one Wednesday evening! He has been a testimony in the park as he plays, in Sunday school when there are more visitors than workers to witness, and as we are out and about. Timo won a boy to Christ during a teen activity at a park recently. The boy attended church with him the next service. What a joy to serve alongside our family doing the work closest to the heart of Christ!



We have a specific prayer request for our faithful prayer warriors. “. . . *The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest.*” (Luke 10:2) Our need for pastors has not been greater. We need the Lord to direct us to the right men to invest in and to be up to the challenge of pastoring. There is much work to be done. We work while it is still day, because evening comes when no man will work anymore. Please pray with us for pastors to partner with us in church multiplication here in Peru.
