Andrew has been saved for many years, but he had never been scripturally baptized. Becky and I are meeting with Tracy on a weekly basis, going through discipleship. Becky had the privilege of leading Tracy to the Lord in late October. Joshua got saved in November. His family are faithful members of Anchor Baptist.
