

Many of our young people jumped in to learn instruments, such as the piano, violin, and recorder. My wife Sheryl is also teaching herself piano. She already knows how to play 10 congregational songs! As a pastor I am humbled by their sweet spirits! I love the fact that all our instrumentalists are involved in either soul winning or teaching/helping in our Children's Extension Class. We also have a couple more adults and teenagers now who go soul winning and visiting on Saturdays. We started a teen route a couple months ago. By God's grace, all of the teenagers involved in this route have won several people to the Lord and have brought visitors from the route!

We started a Discipleship Program this year. We have been discipling a married couple named Ronald and Lerma, whom my wife personally led to the Lord last year. It is great watching them get excited, especially when we talked about Heaven. It's also great watching them grow spiritually! One Sunday they didn't have money for fare to go to church. They only had 100 pesos (US\$2.50), but that was their only money to buy them food. They decided to step out in faith by going to church and letting God take care of their food. Sure enough, God provided them food! When they got home from church, one of their relatives stopped by their house and gave them several fish and even some money! Nobody knew their needs at the time—only God!

We also have another married couple whom I and my staff translator personally led to the Lord in a hospital. The husband Christopher has come to our church one time but sends his kids, Charles and Charm, every Sunday. Christopher has a problem with drinking. He joined the Jehovah's Witnesses for two years because they promised him that they could help change him; but, according to his wife, he still gets drunk every night. We assured his wife Christina that we could help him, but it was not us or our religion that could change him. It is only God and the Bible that could and would change him as long as he has the heart to change. Our staff has started discipling him. Please pray that the Word of God and the Holy Spirit will begin to work in his heart.

We look forward to a wonderful 2015. Many things are planned this year—more discipleship and more extension classes, just to name some. It sure is exciting to serve the Lord. We pray that the Lord blesses you this year as you continue to serve Him.
