Adam Ogle, program director for TAN, and his wife Cesia traveled to Lima, Peru, last month to survey the need for a Bible institute there. Inglasia Bautista International, pastored by Dan Hubbard, has asked Teaching All Nations to help establish a Bible institute with his church in Lima. In addition, there are several sister churches that want to join this effort as well. The Ogle family will be moving to Peru as soon as their support level is sufficient. While in Peru, Adam and Cesia accomplished the following:

- Spoke at a family camp, which had over 55 families in attendance
- Introduced Teaching All Nations to 9 pastors attending the camp
- Encouraged 2 pastors from Trujillo, Peru, to begin a Bible institute in 2015
