In a few weeks, we’ll be beginning a new semester in our Bible college. The great achievement of the last semester was that the new students who began the semester all completed their classes. Most commonly this is unusual; that is why we are being careful concerning those who want to study in our college. Our purpose with these students is to start new churches in the near future.

I would like to thank those who have been interested to know about my father’s health. The Lord has worked in his body in a special way. After suffering a heart attack, his right hand was affected with some neurological damage, but miraculously, it has recovered 90% of its use. This month another family will leave the island. As you know, the Caribbean needs missionaries, and for one reason or another, those we do have are returning to their countries of origin. I also ask you to pray for us, especially for our three children: Endhy, Liliana, and Caleb; pray that the Lord will keep them always in obedience to His Word and that the grace of God would be poured on them by helping them build really Christian homes that glorify the Lord.

A total of 104 received Christ during the months of April and May. To God be the glory for what He is doing. We express our gratitude to each of you for your love and confidence in investing in us so that we can continue to invest our lives in the proclamation of the Gospel of our "great God and Saviour Jesus Christ."
