May 6-8 we conducted a Vacation Bible School for our church kids and as an outreach to the kids in our community. We had over 500 in attendance each day. We divided the kids up into 19 classes and taught them lessons on salvation, and 66 children trusted Christ as their Saviour!

Two weeks ago a group of our church soul winners were invited to the palace of the Bohyen chief. (The Bohyen chief is the local land chief over the area where our church is located.) We were able to witness to the chief and six of his family members. I had the privilege of preaching the Gospel to the chief personally for over one hour. I am convinced he understands clearly how to be saved; however, he said he was not yet ready to make that decision. The majority of chiefs here perform many idolatrous practices as part of their job.
