In the meantime, I took Gregg and Angel’s two oldest boys with me to help churches.

He is bringing them back to health. Praise His name! As Pastor Dice always says, “**God is good, all the time!**” Please continue to pray for them.

God Never Loses Track: While we were visiting bus families in Tampa, Florida, in February, the bus captain introduced me to Heather, a mother of some bus kids. I asked her if she had gone to church when she was younger. She said, “Yes.” She had been a bus kid at Lewis Avenue Baptist Church in Temperance, Michigan, and she had trusted Jesus as her own personal Saviour and been baptized when she was there. Now, fast forward to April when we were helping work on buses at Lewis Avenue Baptist Church. I mentioned her name to Pastor Steve Hobbins. He remembered that years ago, when he was a teenage bus captain, she had been one of his bus riders. He was very happy for her. We may lose track of them, but God never loses track of them!
