At the end of June and into July, we had the best Teen Camp we've ever had! We took 24 teenagers, along with 6 adults, to the jungle village of Coroico. The last day of the camp, the young people who memorized the most verses and kept the best attitudes got to go down the zip line of death!

This time I was so worn out that I could not get my thoughts together, but when invitation time came, they just melted. It was the longest invitation I have ever been a part of in my life.

We just kept singing and crying and telling testimonies and singing and crying and telling testimonies until about 1:00 a.m. Then I had to shut it down because we had to leave

early in the morning. It was such a sweet time together to experience a revival and God's presence in such a marvelous way with some of the people I love!
