One of the highlights of being stateside was being able to visit some of our faithful supporters in various states. We enjoyed seeing and spending time with the faithful saints of God who have supported our ministry and family for many years.

God blessed this brief trip with 3 souls trusting Christ as their Saviour. After learning of our plans for our trip, Pastor Jim Callen asked me the cost of the round-trip tickets. Pastor Callen recommended to the members of Eastern Avenue Baptist Church to pay for our airline tickets. We were overwhelmed and grateful that Eastern Avenue Baptist Church voted to provide us \$1,500.00 to pay the full cost of our tickets! Thank you, Pastor Callen and people, for your generosity.
