Dear Praying Friends,

My wife went to visit a first-time visitor but couldn't find her house, so she just started knocking doors where she was. She knocked on a door, and a teenage girl came out. Misty witnessed to her, and she got saved. A couple of weeks later, Misty went back to invite the girl to a special day we were having at church, and she was able to witness to her mom also. She had been raised believing that she had to do good works in order to go to Heaven. While my wife was witnessing to her, she said, "Now I understand. My good works will not save me. Only Jesus can save me." She then bowed her head and sweetly asked Jesus to save her from Hell. I can't help but think that this was a direct response to the prayers of God's people.

Many people who have come to our church are from a town called Las Lomas, which is about 30 minutes away. I have gone there several times to witness to lost family members of those who come to our church. It is a wicked town where not many church-going people live. We decided to go soul winning there every Saturday with the church. After we knock every door, we are planning on having a special open-air meeting to preach the Gospel. Please pray that that the Lord would help the people of Las Lomas to understand salvation and get saved.
