Bus Clinic: At Bible Baptist Church in York, Pennsylvania, we held a Bus Ministry Clinic for Pastor Bill Schutt. We had training for the bus mechanics, drivers, and bus workers. I went with the bus director and visited some young people who had stopped coming to Sunday school. It is a joy to me to go on the bus routes with the bus captains and talk to the riders about the Lord Jesus, Who loves them and died for them.
