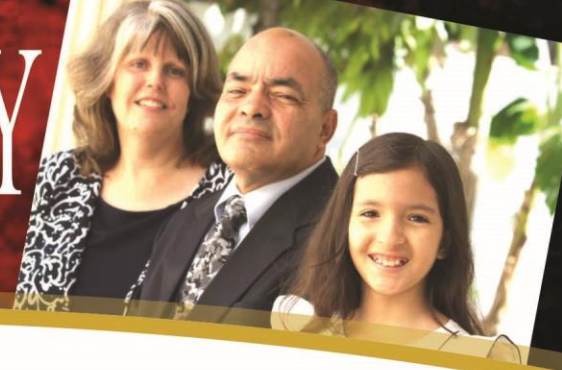

We prayed and worked diligently to obtain our temporary residency. There were plenty of speed bumps along the way, but God gave us the victory! Our ultimate goal is to obtain our permanent residency, which will involve more prayers, work, and patience. We thank each church and individual that prayed with and for us so that we could obtain our residency.

Just in the past 10 days, our God has given us the privilege of leading 14 precious souls to Jesus Christ. Seven were saved out soul winning, and the other 7 were saved in our church services. One thing that is certainly not lacking on our field is the need of people to be saved.

Please pray for our new converts to grow in grace and in the knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ as we work to disciple them. In the 22 years since we have served as missionaries with FBMI, we have never had to return back from the fields of Puerto Rico or the Dominican Republic for the sole purpose of raising more support. Praise the Lord for that! Since January of this year, 10 of our supporting churches have not been able to send us support. We ask you to pray that our support would continue to be sufficient for our family and ministry in the Dominican Republic.
