I would like to start the letter thanking all those who have been praying for us because of the constant storms we have experienced in recent months. Over 50 bridges collapsed due to the heavy rains. Damages have been to the southern and northern parts of the island. Here in the capital, everything has been calm. Thanks be to the Lord for His care for us

Sometimes the Lord works in an unusual way to save sinners. Dozens of people have received Christ lately. A brother of our church and a relative of a sister died. I had the privilege of preaching in both funeral services. Literally hundreds of people came to the funeral home to give condolences to the mourners (relatives). I always give an invitation for salvation to the families and friends. It has been surprising how many people have received the Lord as their Saviour. Glory to God! My brethren, let us never forget that salvation is by faith and that whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved (Romans 10:13). Sometimes the Lord takes some people to Heaven so that others can hear the Gospel and be saved.

As always, we have been very busy. **In the month of April, we held our first program of the year (every Sunday of April), and 53 precious souls received Christ, making a public profession of faith, throughout the month.** In May, we began to win souls in the neighborhood of Sodom and Gomorrah (as we have named it). This place is located in the middle of the motels of the capital. As its name indicates, it is a place of much sin and immorality. We are very hopeful that we will win many to the Lord in this place. In fact, an average of 10 people have been coming to church every Sunday since we started a bus route there; several have also been baptized. **During the months of March, April, and May, a total of 199 people received the Gospel.**
