 National Pastor Spotlight**

Pastor Collins Agyei: "A 15-year-old boy named Kwabena Appiah got saved and joined 'The Way of Salvation' Bible Club at Bekwei. He is now a member of our choir." – *Adwafo, Lake Bosomtwe, Ghana*

Pastor Rexford Aning: "An answer to prayer is that Sunday services are now being held at our second church plant, which is in Sosuano. My convert Bismark is preaching there each week.
