The Widow of Yakima, Washington

It is written: *"How that in a great trial of affliction the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded unto the riches of their liberality."* (II Corinthians 8:2) Great have been the positive marks left by the pastors and churches that I have visited so far on deputation. I have been privileged to be an eyewitness of the grace of God bestowed upon them through soul winning, Sunday school, discipleship, hospitality, the Bus Ministry, and other areas of the ministry. Deeply do I thank God for blessing me with six meetings this month, allowing me to learn from seasoned, faithful servants of God. I learned about how to stay fresh always, run a visitation program smoothly, better serve God's people, and draw out counsel from the Word of God and the man of God. Now I would like to highlight one of the many events that moved me.

It was October 3. I was heading to Yakima, Washington, from Summerville Baptist Church, where I was the beneficiary of an exceptionally outstanding treatment by Pastor Humber and the church there. I had no meeting scheduled for the following Wednesday, so I attended Yakima Baptist Church. God worked mightily by opening a door for me to present my ministry. Praise the Lord! At the end of the service, an older woman approached Pastor Brown and me with a dollar bill to be given to missions. She may not have been a widow. She may not have been the Mark 12:41-44 "certain woman." Nonetheless, she gave joyfully. She probably gave all that she had. She probably gave out of the abundance of her poverty. She may have realized that her giving out of sacrifice would keep missionaries on the mission field, send more missionaries, and keep souls out of Hell. God taught me a valuable lesson through her. He reminded me of the vital and urgent need to take the Gospel to a lost and dying world.






