Jon's Testimony

By God's grace, I was reared in a Christian home and learned from parents in full-time ministry. From a young age, I was exposed to the Bible and the Gospel message. I was taught how to have a relationship with Christ and what it meant to serve the Lord. At the age of fifteen, I attended a revival meeting at our church. I clearly remember the message about Heaven and Hell. I was convicted during the whole message, and during the invitation, I met my dad at the altar and trusted in Jesus Christ alone. That year at a Youth Conference, I surrendered to God's will to serve Him however He would call me. God kept working on my heart and led me to pursue His will and train for the ministry at Bible college.

After graduating high school, I attended Hyles-Anderson College where God allowed Brittany and me to meet. We dated for three years and were married on March 11, 2016. God brought us together to serve Him. During college I took several missions classes, and God put a burden on my heart for those outside of the U.S. While praying about what God would have us do, the Lord put the country of Thailand on our hearts on several different occasions. After graduating college, we moved to Martinsburg, West Virginia, and worked for Pastor Corey Bane as Christian school teachers and youth workers. In the summer of 2016, my home pastor, Bruce Goddard, gave my wife and me the opportunity to go on a survey trip to Thailand. Seeing the people in spiritual blindness and bondage, God made it known to us that Thailand is where He wants us to serve Him. Thailand and its surrounding countries are part of what is known as the 10/40 Window, the poorest and spiritually darkest area of the world. It is our mission to spread God's Light in this darkness and give the hope of the Gospel to those in need.

I also had the privilege of growing up in a Christian home with parents in full-time ministry, and I accepted Christ as my Saviour when I was ten years old. A few years later, my family surrendered to be missionaries to the Jewish people in the country of Israel. My teen years were spent traveling the country to raise support on deputation. The summer before my senior year, our family moved to Jerusalem, Israel, and began a work reaching Jews and Gentiles alike. These experiences gave me an understanding of what it is like to travel and raise financial support, live in a culture outside of America, learn another language, and have a burden for world missions. Through Bible college, God brought Jon and me together to serve as a team and has called us to the foreign field of Thailand. We have truly been blessed by God, and we cannot wait to be in our future home, telling others about Him.

OUR MISSION

We plan to join a team of missionaries in Hua Hin, Thailand, sent by Fundamental Baptist Missions International (FBMI), and work with the International Baptist Church of Hua Hin. We believe God has called us to Thailand to preach the Gospel, baptize and disciple converts, start new churches, and teach and train the next generation in Southeast Asia. During our first few years in Thailand, we will focus on learning the Thai language and culture while actively serving in the church's ministries. Team Thailand has already seen thousands of Thai people saved and baptized, planted new churches, and has plans to start a Bible institute in the near future.
