Then when they grow up, we eventually lose them because they get discouraged and stop attending church. Here in the Dominican Republic, the church has to fight with the Devil and the baseball offers to keep our young people in church. It's a great victory when we win the whole family for Christ.

The new semester in our Bible college will begin the second week of September. Please pray for more students to enroll in our college. Last semester we had three new students, and all three finished the semester well. We want God to continue using us to train strong pastors and leaders for our churches.

Of all the people who were saved in the last few months, Elaine and Ñaña decided to be baptized. We thank the Lord for those who have obeyed the Lord in baptism during this year.
