We are glad to have friends like you who pray and give and allow us to provide the Word of God to those who have never seen a Bible. Another container of Scriptures is well on its way to Bangkok. Dr. Curtis Hall has arrived in time to coordinate the distribution of this much-needed Scripture. Our warehouse in Rangsit is nearly empty again.

Dr. Hall also assisted the Todd Painter family on their arrival in Bangkok. This will be the Painters' last survey trip before moving to Hua Hin in January 2020 to start language school. The Painter family will be working with the Karen people in Southern Thailand and assisting Team Thailand under the leadership of Tim Shook. God truly has His hand on the work in Southern Thailand. The team is in the process of purchasing their own property. Amazing!

Missionary Andy Long, my distributor in Northern Thailand, informed me that our local printer completed printing all the projects that we laid out in January, and they were delivered to our main distribution center in Rangsit. Dr. Hall organized the material to get it ready to distribute to pastors around that area.

During the month of May, I went a little overboard with having two more major surgeries. My doctor informed me that three surgeries in less than seven weeks was a little too much! Most of June was spent in physical therapy and getting me back on my feet. *"The LORD hath done great things for us; whereof we are glad."*
