Dear Friends and Supporting Churches,

The work in Cristo Rey, Guatemala, continues strong. Last month we were privileged to have a group of young people from Longview, Texas, who came to do an evangelist work here. Brother Juan Meave, the activities director of the Texas Independent Baptist Seminary, came with his wife Samantha and four others—Monica, Teresa, David, and Madison, all from Longview. They were joined by a youth pastor from Lincoln, Nebraska, Brother Joshua Looper. During their visit to our church, we saw 767 persons trust Christ as their Saviour, right here in our area. We also spent a day in the town of Cuilapa, Santa Rosa, to help our fellow missionary, Brother Hector Pivaral, in his ministry there, although I do not have numbers from the results of that effort.

We often face obstacles when working outside of the urban zones; for example, illiteracy and transportation difficulties. Last Sunday, six young people came to church, and two of them did not know how to read and write. We offered to teach them to read and write, so that they can be able to read and study the Bible. Another obstacle is the lack of transportation to bring more people to church. Please pray for this need. Pray that the Lord will provide a meeting place in the village of Puerta Negra, San Jose Pinula, where the need is great and where the people are open to the Gospel.
