

They did a great job, and the Lord brought 10 children. One trusted the Lord, and 2 more received assurance of salvation. Then during our Teen Rally, we had 9 teens, which was a record number and a blessing, since I was expecting only 2; 4 of the teens trusted the Lord as their Saviour. The last day, I was able to take them to visit the Gap of Dunloe. That week while the rally was happening, Kelly and Keith II were packing for a trip to the States for a month. They left the day after the rally, and I was left with the two youngest boys. They were very well behaved and helpful. I was even able to change light fixtures, paint the hall and bathroom, and have two visitors over for dinner before Kelly got home. We had 5 visitors during August.
