Pastor George Menyon: "Praise the Lord for His countless blessings, which He has continued to bestow on my family and me and the ministry here in Liberia. Though all churches in Liberia were ordered closed because of the Coronavirus, our church was still active in soul winning and reaching new converts. From March through May 2020, we had over 400 people saved, and over 1,000 people heard the Gospel preached to them. In May of this year, we made our first survey trip to Sanniquellie, the central city of Nimba County, where we are planning to start a new fundamental Baptist church. Sanniquellie lies 180 miles from Monrovia and has a border with the Republic of Guinea. Lord willing, we will make the second survey trip to Sanniquellie soon.
