The Coronavirus crisis has brought an unexpected time for the whole earth. Our church has had to make great changes to subsist and keep serving God. As the pastor, I have learned that God is in control. This crisis has helped me to rest on Him to formulate the changes that I have had to make and to make wise decisions to avoid the church getting discouraged and the enemy taking advantage by causing the weak to abandon the faith.

By the Lord's grace, most have returned to congregate after more than five months without doing so. There are some who have delicate diseases and have not returned. The children and teenagers who were coming alone haven't been allowed to return, but I have visited them several times. I told their parents that the church has decided that only if they come with an adult can we accept them.

**The government has a 7:00 p.m. curfew throughout the country, trying to curb the number of infected. Throughout the Caribbean, the Dominican Republic is the most infected country. In spite of this situation, we have continued reaching sinners with the Gospel, and in the last few weeks, we have been baptizing a group of brothers every Sunday.**
