When we bought our minivan in 2017, it had 82,000 miles on it. It now has over 170,000 miles. Roughly 30,000 - 35,000 of those miles have been for deputation purposes. Thank you so much for being a part of this amazing journey of deputation. We are excited to be leaving for the field in just a couple of months.
