In 2019, Emmanuella graduated from our school, and soon thereafter, she was hired to work in the elementary learning center. In addition to teaching in our Christian school, Emmanuella teaches a Sunday school class in our children's department. Emmanuella has grown to become a fine young Christian lady.
