Pastor Christian Gafatsi: “I met Sarah at her friend’s store at Bediako. I witnessed to her about Christ, and she trusted Christ Jesus as her personal Saviour. At the beginning of our conversation, she believed that if a person believed in Christ Jesus and did good work, he would go to Heaven, but after she heard the Gospel, she believed in Christ alone for her salvation. She has now started attending our church faithfully.
