Dear Friends and Supporting Churches,

It's our pleasure once again to send you greetings from Guatemala and report on our activities here.

Some time ago, we reached a family of six while soul winning in the town of San Jose Pinula. Now, after three years of trials, struggles, and difficulties, the Gutierrez family has decided to come faithfully to church. Last Sunday, the father and mother of this family got married in our church, and next Sunday we will begin training the father on how to win souls. In that same service, another recent convert, whom we are discipling, was baptized. Only God can do works like these.

The saying, "Prayer changes things," certainly came true over the urgent prayer request that we sent you last month. You may recall that this was about the ongoing property-line dispute with one of our neighbors here. The County Commissioner of our county of residence has gotten involved on our behalf and is offering to settle the matter by sending a personal representative to come and speak to this neighbor, restore the property line to where it's supposed to be, and grant authority to have a wall built on that line immediately—and with police presence if necessary. I spoke to the commissioner on the phone, and we have set the date of August 5 to do this. Praise God for His work in this matter, and please keep praying!

Last month we held our first-ever, church-wide Women's Conference, where vital issues were taught to our ladies by ladies, and many important decisions were made at the altar. We thank God for this good work that He has done in the hearts and lives of our people through this effort.

Please pray for our daughter, Tabitha Daniella (Lucy). They will be operating on her chest this week in Indiana.

Your prayers are helping us to reach Guatemalan people like these, and your support enables us to stay in the battle for souls here in this field. Thank you!
