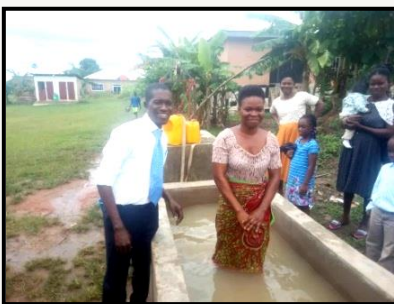
## Church Plant and National Pastor Spotlight
