Dear Friends and Supporting Churches.

"Remove not the old landmark; and enter not into the fields of the fatherless." (Proverbs 23.10)

Soon after sending off our last prayer letter, I caught a bad cold, and then I came down with a fever. I quickly went to get tested for COVID and found out that I was COVID-positive. The weeks following, I stayed home while battling this deadly disease. My wife did not catch COVID. About two weeks ago, I had recovered enough strength to be able to start holding meetings again. I'm still weak and have not fully recovered from COVID's after-effects, but I'm gradually getting back to my old self. Thank you for your prayers.

Because of this, we temporarily closed our home-base church, while keeping most of our missions open. Last Sunday, we opened up the church again and held our first regular church service here since early September.

Victory Report

About 10 years ago, I began praying about a property-line dispute with our neighbors on the northwest side of our property. I specifically explained the problem and asked you to pray with me about this in our prayer letter of May 2019 and again in an emergency prayer request this past June 2021. Then—BOOM—the trees fell! (Ecclesiastes 11:3) In what was an obvious act of God, three big, heavy trees that were right on the line of the disputed property simply fell over by their own weight, one after another, onto the neighbor's property.

This happened in April of last year. The removal of these trees created a public-works emergency over the need to prevent a landslide, and this got the local village mayors and county commissioner involved on our behalf. Now the dividing line has finally been fixed, and the retaining wall is being built right in front of their faces. This was a huge victory! God answers prayer!
