Divine Appointment: While we were doing our laundry in Georgetown, Kentucky, we met Lisa, the attendant. God saved her after we gave her the Gospel message, and she received the assurance of her salvation. She told us that years before, she had been a bus kid at Dr. Jeff Fugate's dad's church in Hazzard, Kentucky. She lives in Lexington, Kentucky, and she said she was looking forward to meeting Dr. Fugate and visiting his church there.
