Of course, the most important part of the service was the preaching of the Word of God. The Gospel was preached with power. The Holy Spirit brought conviction to sinners. We thank the Lord for the dozens of people who received the Lord Jesus Christ. The church members challenged themselves to continue bringing visitors.

The church ended February with a total of 61 first-time adult visitors, and 19 of those returned more than once. We pray there will be fruit that remains!

Recently, I was asked to preach a funeral service for the aunt of one of our church members. There were about 60 people in attendance. I had liberty to preach the Gospel, and about 10 people received the Lord Jesus Christ as their Saviour.

Last September, we had an all-night men's prayer meeting, with one of the main focuses being to pray for those who are in authority. We pray that God will give them wisdom and that they will give glory, honor, and praise to Him.
