## Church Plant and National Pastor Spotlight

Your support for missions is being multiplied here in West Africa. Men have been trained and sent out to reach others for Christ. Please pray for these men, their ministries, and their families.

**Pastor Otchere Boachie:** “Some weeks ago, one of our church members called Aunty Mansah passed away. She had heard the Gospel and trusted Christ for her salvation. We got the opportunity to preach at her funeral, and about 35 people trusted Christ. Some of her family members came to our church to give thanks for a successful funeral, and when we checked their understanding of salvation, they gave us the right answers. Thank God for the power of the Gospel and Heaven.” – *Fundamental Baptist Church, Kunsu, Ashanti Region, Ghana* [After graduating from our Bible college in February 2018, Pastor Boachie began serving as an evangelist on our church staff. In May 2021, he began pastoring the church in Kunsu.]

**Pastor Rexford Aning:** “Amina is the wife of my convert, Ibrahim John. I preached the Gospel to her, and she trusted Christ as her Saviour. She then traveled for some time. When she came back from her trip, I taught her about baptism, and she got baptized the following Sunday. Praise the Lord!
