Our oldest daughter Lydia received some midwifery training from a local midwife by the name of Ana Saput. While working with Ana, the Lord burdened Lydia's heart to witness to her. Even though she shared the Gospel with her several times, Ana didn't get saved. Lydia often mentioned her name for salvation when we prayed as a family. Just before she went off to Bible college this fall, Lydia witnessed to her one more time. This time, Ana received the gift of eternal life. In the next few minutes, Sonia was sweetly saved. When her husband returned, we told him the good news about how Sonia had turned to Christ for salvation, and we all rejoiced together.
