National Pastor Spotlight**

The work continues! Here are more testimonies from several of our national pastors.

Pastor Collins Agyei: “I thank God for the preaching of the Gospel. This month was a blessing to our church. The Gospel was preached to 3 different villages around the lake, and tracts were given out. At the end of the preaching, about 38 souls believed in the Lord, and 6 of them joined our church. We are planning to start a new church at Edwenasi next year. Please pray for us as we are planning to reach that area for Christ. Thank you for your support. Their names are Mariama, Ajalah, Shakina and Rashida.
