During our last week in the States, I was honored to perform the beautiful wedding ceremony of Ryan and Hannah Marks. It was my first wedding, and to say I was nervous would be a total understatement. As always though, God moved throughout the ceremony, and it was completely beautiful and Christ-honoring! Andy and a few members from his church came out one last time to run our evening Bible study and to transition everything back over to us. As of right now, the adults meet with me in a small tent in our front yard while the children cram under our porch with Mrs. Ali in our backyard.
