I was thrilled to present and preach their afternoon service. From there, we went south to Rochester, Pennsylvania, where I presented and taught the Wednesday night service at Sylvania Hills Baptist Church. What a wonderful way to end the month!

This month we were able to fully present the Gospel to **three** souls. I went out on Thursday night soul winning in downtown Madison, Wisconsin, right outside the university.
