You and your church have a part in the work God is doing through our church plants. Here are testimonies from four of the men with whom we are privileged to partner. Please pray for them and their ministries.

Pastor Rexford Aning: "The Lord once again blessed our service with four baptisms; three of the four—Annalisa, Yvonne, and Philipa—are with me in the picture. Philipa is the one on the right side of the picture. Annalisa (in the middle) already comes with her mum, but Yvonne (left) and Philipa (right) are in the church because of our school.
