Due to the public schools having a very short summer break (in order to "make up" for the COVID lockdowns), we had to fit both our annual Youth Rally and Vacation Bible School into July.

Our Youth Rally was blessed by the Lord. We had 7 preachers deliver 13 messages in less than 3 days to 148

registered teens. We provided the meals and overnight lodging, making for a busy schedule. God blessed the theme of *God and Grit* with many decisions made, including decisions to attend Bible college.

Our VBS was also a blessed time. We divided up our area into 21 locations, with daily meetings Monday through Thursday. On Friday, we had a big meeting together at our church property.
