Divine Appointments: The last of September, we had the privilege of attending the Servants' Retreat at Mackinac Island, Michigan. Our pastor, Dr. John Wilkerson, was the guest speaker, and his lovely wife Linda spoke to the ladies. Not only was it a wonderful time, but we had the privilege of seeing three precious souls saved when we shared the Gospel with them. Two of them, Amoy and Maya, were from Jamaica, and both of them have family in Jamaica. They gave us their family information to give to Missionary Oral Anderson, who said he would go to their family members and witness to them.

Our truck needed new tires, so I had a tire shop put them on for me. Afterward, I went to get a quick lunch, and there was an elderly man sitting there eating alone. He struck up a conversation with me, and I went and sat by him. I shared the good news of the Gospel with him, and 91-year-old Mr. Chaney bowed his head and trusted Christ as his personal Saviour. God is so good!

Bus Mechanics' Prayer Portal: We have started a conference call for church bus mechanics (anybody who works on church buses). It starts at 8:00 a.m. Eastern Standard Time and goes 30 to 45 minutes.
