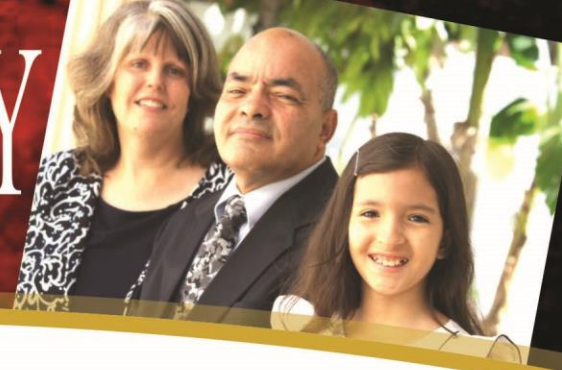


# *The* TIRADO FAMILY
