Your support for missions is being multiplied here in West Africa. Men have been trained and sent out to reach others for Christ. Please pray for these men, their ministries, and their families.

Pastor Collins Agyei: “The people around Lake Bosomtwe, where I have my ministry, are mainly subsistence farmers and fishermen. In a recent month, we reached out to three villages (Obo, Abaase, and Nyetiase) with the Gospel, while at the same time training the villagers in soap making. Many were saved, and the people were grateful to us for caring about not only their spiritual needs but their physical needs as well.” – *Fundamental Baptist Church, Adwafo, Ashanti Region, Ghana* [Pastor Agyei graduated from our Bible college in September 2010.]

I’ve been going soul winning with them twice weekly.
